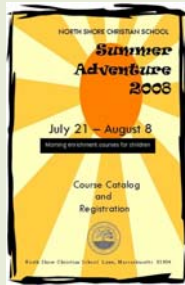
and I will get you connected.

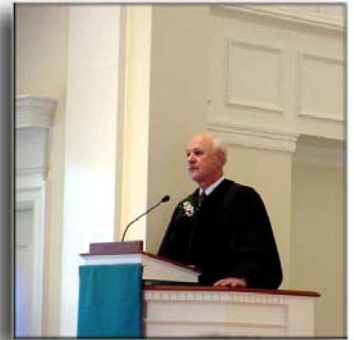
Grade 8 Graduation
